HOMEWORK

We hope you have now established a routine for practice and are enjoying your son's singing throughout the week. Memorisation is a key component for performance at Choir and in order to memorise music correctly it is important to practise at home.

Create a practice routine including breathing exercises, vocal warmups and repertoire learning. Please use the tracks to assist learning the correct melodies, breathing and words for each song. Practising for 15 to 30 minutes daily can greatly improve your son's music and singing abilities. We need to express how important it is for the boys to spend time each week at home revising the skills they are learning at Choir.

PERSONAL DETAILS AND HECS FORMS – urgent!


