HOMEWORK

Please keep learning and working on each song in your practice each week. The aim is to have everything memorised by the time we meet back together face-to-face. Your focus repertoire this week is *Ribbons in the Sky* (top part), *Placement One in C* (top part) and *Long Legged Sailor*.

Practice tips:

- Always start with your breathing exercises and vocal warmups
- Set yourself a goal to work towards for each song when you practise (for example, following music, memorising words, feeling the beat, intonation/pitch)
- Write down your goal to share at our next rehearsal
- Drink plenty of water to keep yourself hydrated

Each week you will have the rehearsal video and live zoom call where we will continue working on our repertoire and learning new vocal skills. Make sure you include these in your practice routine. The repertoire list below shows what music is to be practised at home.
