If you would like your son to attend rehearsal at our studios next week, please contact the Office by 5.00pm this Sunday, June 21. As restrictions ease again this weekend, we will be allowed to have up to 50 people in the Casey Studio – so we would be delighted to welcome all Elementary Choristers who are able to come next Wednesday 24 June, for the final rehearsal this term.

If your son has a face mask from last week, please would you check that it fits. The elastic can be knotted or cut if necessary. Masks need to be washed and brought clean into the rehearsal in the satchel or in a pocket.

Please do not send your son into the building wearing a mask.

The doors will not be opened before 4.35pm – please wait in the car, rather than queuing up in the cold.

We suggest you might have your son practise wearing a face mask at home, to get used to the idea. They don't need to be worn for Zoom rehearsals. Please reassure him that they are only a precaution, like wearing a seat belt in a car. There are still no reports of infection connected to the Choir community. If your son cannot wear a face mask, please contact the Office.

A quick reminder of the procedure going forward:

- Drop off/pick up in the carpark doors open at 4.35pm
- Sanitise and temperature check at the door with staff
- Cloth face masks will be issued at rehearsal

- Spatial distancing of 1.5 metres is required (no close contact) follow the floor markings
- Bring music satchel, pencil, eraser, sharpener, water bottle, sanitiser
- No sharing music, equipment, water bottles
- Wash/sanitise hands after toilet or cough/sneeze
- Exit one by one staff to supervise

HOMEWORK



We've come back and had our first face-to-face rehearsal! It was so lovely to see some choristers back last week and we look forward to hopefully seeing all of you in the coming weeks. We experienced a few technical issues with the internet last week, so we appreciated your patience and we hope you enjoyed the split rehearsal.

Your practice focus this week continues from last week with attention to your **POSTURE** and **BREATHING**! This has slipped a little over the last number of weeks.

Please be mindful of how you are standing to practise. Remember, as you breathe in expand your tummy and keep those shoulders relaxed. A great way to practise this is to first start on the floor with our breathing exercises and then move in front of a mirror and watch yourself while you sing. Check that you are expanding while keeping those shoulders relaxed and still.
