CORONAVIRUS RESTRICTIONS

With the introduction of Stage 4 restrictions in Victoria, the Choir offices will close on Wednesday evening, and staff will work only from home. It will not be permissible under these restrictions to visit the Ringwood studios. Rehearsals will continue as scheduled on Zoom and will be unaffected by the new restrictions.
