Any change to the regular Junior rehearsal schedule, due to health warnings, will be advised via email to all families, usually within an hour of announcements being made.


#### **HOMEWORK**

Please observe the Choir's **COVID-Safe Plan**:

- All rehearsals are held at our Ringwood studios in person unless otherwise advised
- Please drop off and pick-up your son from the carpark the office will be available after rehearsal has commenced, but the foyer remains closed
- Doors will open <u>five minutes</u> before rehearsal commences
- On arrival, boys will be asked to sanitise their hands
- Boys will move straight to their places in the studio, keeping a 1.5 metre distance away from each other, following the tape markings on the floor
- Boys are reminded to wash their hands thoroughly after using the toilet, and to cough or sneeze into a tissue, handkerchief or their elbow

## Friendly reminders...

- ✓ **URGENT:** Email or phone us your expression of interest for Sunday's Fun Run/Walk

- ✓ PRIORITY: Homework items, breathing and posture, use practice tracks and videos
